# Rosh Hashanah

**Exodus 23:14-17 (NKJV)**  
<sup>14</sup> "Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year:  
<sup>15</sup> You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty);  
<sup>16</sup> and the Feast of Harvest, the firstfruits of your labors which you have sown in the field; and the **Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year (Rosh Hashanah)** when you have gathered in *the fruit of your labors* from the field.  
<sup>17</sup> Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord GOD.

## A Celebration of GOD!

If there is anything we could all agree on, it is the fact that Americans have numerous holidays throughout the year.

We also learn how to celebrate each one very early in life!

For Thanksgiving we have a unique meal that usually takes about 3 days to eat while we watch football games. Christians add a time during the day to give thanks to God for all He has done for us.

Many American Christians have heard of the 3 annual Feasts God appointed, but don't know exactly what they mean, when they are held or how to celebrate them.

Consequently, when we find out Jesus died on Pentecost, rose from the dead on First Fruits, sent the Holy Spirit to the 120 souls in the Upper Room on Pentecost and will likely Rapture the Church at the Feast of Trumpets on Rosh Hashanah, it can be one of the most eye-opening moments in a believer's life! Even though most Christians AND Jews pay little attention to the feasts in our day, **GOD IS STILL KEEPING HIS SIDE OF THE BARGAIN!**

Why would I use that terminology? Because God's road to His blessings goes right through the tunnels of the Feasts. This road also leads you directly into your gifts, blessings and success in this life.

But let me explain something about these feasts. They are filled with spiritual concepts and life sized illustrations. Israel's failure was their lack of truly understanding God's love and forgiveness. Without the right understanding of the purpose of Passover, you could easily go home that night believing God must be the most blood thirsty being in the universe!

On the other hand, if you can connect Passover to the blood of Jesus on the Cross, washing away the sin of every soul on earth, you have embraced God's love and forgiveness on an entirely different level! You also have experienced the real Pentecost, which provides you with a feast in your heart! And Tabernacles gives you a solid faith in the return of Jesus to restore the Earth!

Over the past several years, we have given more time and energy to the feasts, so that people can be aware of their lessons. Honestly, true praise and worship can only be accomplished through the spiritual knowledge the feasts reveal.

Rosh Hashanah celebrates the goodness and mercy God gave us in the last 12 months. It gives us a green light to shout, scream and wave flags in thanks for His blessings. It also looks forward to the new year before us with great expectations of a better year in 2019.

Thursday night in Texas, Dutch Sheets preached extensively on the Holy Spirit "Hovering" over numerous things in the Bible. Each time, supernatural power to multiply was manifested. He shouted to the crowd, 'believe God for multiplication during this next year in every area of your life and the lives of your loved ones and acquaintance's. The Holy Spirit is coming to Hover over this nation like nothing any of us have ever seen!' All things are possible to him who believes!
