Removing the Curse from Your Family!

The final verse of the Old Testament makes a statement that we must all confront. Here it is.

Malachi 4:5-6 (NASB)

⁵ "Behold, I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of the LORD.

⁶ "He will restore the hearts of the fathers to *their* children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, so that I will not come and smite the land with a curse."

Let's identify Elijah the Prophet in this verse.

Matthew 11:13-15 (NASB)

¹³ "For all the prophets and the Law prophesied until John.

¹⁴ "And if you are willing to accept *it*, John himself is Elijah who was to come.

¹⁵ "He who has ears to hear, let him hear.

So the Lord Jesus was the one letting the people know that John the Baptist was the guy who would restore the Father's hearts to their children and the children to their Fathers.

But how would John get that massive job done? By Baptizing the parents and the kids as they confessed their sins! The hearts of parents and children alike were turned by their public proclamation of faith in God! It is imperative for us to understand the power of the Cross is the only requirement to remove any demonic curse! Here's why.

Galatians 3:13-14 (NASB)

¹³ Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us— for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"—

¹⁴ in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Every family on Earth has sin in their blood. If they didn't, they couldn't die, because they would have no death in them.

When Jesus hung on the Cross, He did far more than most Christians realize. He not only restored the hearts of the Fathers and their children and exchanged our sin for His righteousness, He also took the Satanic curse from our bloodlines through the power of the Holy Spirit.

However, like all of the blessings of God, one thing is required. In the scripture above, it says, *we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith*. Faith believes our brother's curse of alcohol addiction has left, BEFORE we can get that text from him saying he hasn't had a drink for a month!

I encourage everyone to read this section of scripture in Galatians 3:13-14 every day for this next week. Faith comes by hearing God's Word so read it out loud. As you grow in faith, you will can become fully persuaded that Jesus is both willing and able to set your family FREE from curses. There is nothing more important!!
