Fresh Oil for a New Move of God

When I was growing up as a young boy in church the only things that I really liked were singing, communion, and baptisms! I never understood what the preacher was saying so his words were horribly boring to me.

But when Joslyn and I got to Tulsa to start Bible School, everything changed. I had heard about the Bible Belt states, but now we were living in one!

First we passed numerous churches on the way to our destination and most of the parking lots were full. That was a shock but nothing like seeing a helicopter hovering over a brand new church building, placing the most stunning, beautiful cross you have ever seen on the roof.

After all that excitement, I was certainly interested in what might be happening inside the church were going to attend as well.

Although Joslyn new about it, I watched for the first time and with great awe, a ceremony of anointing with oil. The speaker shared numerous scriptures about the commandments concerning both the spices in the oil and the purpose of the oil. He shared the scriptures of Aaron's anointing as the High Priest and his sons as priests before the Lord. He showed us how God told Samuel to take oil to Jesse's house to anoint David the Shepherd boy as the next King of Israel.

He then reminded everyone that one of the foundation stones of Christianity is the laying of hands and anointing with oil those who are being sent into the work of the ministry, which they were about to do. He started by reading this scripture:

1 Peter 2:9-10 (ESV)

⁹ But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

He reminded the people that were going to be anointed that day the truth of these scriptures. Every Christian from the first to the last is part of this chosen generation, royal priesthood and holy nation. We have come out of the darkness into God's Glorious light. Jesus exchanged His perfection for our rejection. He became sin, not just one sin but every sin, for us so that we could be blameless before God. He went before the Hight Court of Heaven and plead our case before God.

Always picture this scene in Heaven. Jesus, the Son of God, is your lawyer. God, the Father of Jesus, is the Judge. The Holy Spirit is inside you, letting God know that your faith in Jesus as your Savior is much greater even than a robust mustard seed! The devil is the District Attorney but he as long since been banned from the court. CASE DISSMISSED!

We are going to anoint everyone in the building today in preparation of The Movement in the Earth that began August 9th. Get ready to participate in Signs, Wonders and Miracles in the days ahead. Let God Arise and His Enemies be Scattered!
