Philippians 1:9-11 (NASB)
⁹ And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment,
¹⁰ so that you may approve the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ; ¹¹ having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

Paul's Prayer Life

I trust you have been both learning some new and remembering some old lessons on effective prayer. Always remember, God wants you to have every prayer answered so you can tell your friends and give God the glory!

Last week we learned about motives being a HUGE aspect of getting your prayers answered. Jesus taught His disciples to ask God for their daily bread and forgiveness on a daily basis.

I would guess most prayer going up to Heaven is about provision to make life more comfortable, wouldn't you? Well check this out - the Apostle Paul prayed with a totally different mindset! Here is a sample. Colossians 1:9-12 (NASB)

⁹ For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, ¹⁰ so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; ¹¹ strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously ¹² giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

The Apostle Paul was one of the most successful leaders the Body of Christ has ever seen! He wrote over half of the New Testament and planted churches all over the Gentile world. He was also bound in a Roman prison for several years, which gave him a chance to develop the most profound prayer life and communication base of all the Apostles. His letters to the churches always included prayer and the prayers conveyed some common themes. Here is a short list of those themes.

- 1) He prayed without ceasing for the churches
- 2) He linked knowing the Will of God with Wisdom and Understanding
- 3) He prayed for believers to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord's calling
- 4) He also prayed for the churches to PLEASE the Lord
- 5) He was tenacious about Increasing their knowledge of God and the Lord Jesus
- 6) He connected strength with God's power and His Glorious Might
- 7) He addressed joy and peace as targets of prayer for helping them give Thanks!
- 8) He frequently prayed for believers to acknowledge their Eternal Inheritance

The Pauline prayers give all of us access to the greatest prayers ever prayed! We have printed copies of these prayers on a table in the lobby. Pray one a day for leaders, family, friends and yourself. In a matter of weeks LIFE WILL CHANGE!

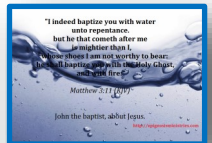
