Are you watching the signs?

Malachi 4:6

“And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.”

Watch those signs!

As you drive down the road, you can see literally 100s of signs! Stop signs, street signs, rail road crossing, school crossing, no right on red, these are some that you may notice, to name a few. And then there are kid's favorites like golden arches, or royalty signs like Burger King and Dairy Queen. Even the youngest readers can recognize these! Did you know there are many signs in the Bible also?

John 2: 1-11 is the account of Jesus' first miracle, turning the water into wine. Verse 11 states, "This beginning of **SIGNS** Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His Glory; and His disciples believed in Him". The signs the disciples saw built their faith and they saw many miracles through the hands of Jesus.

If you walk in spiritual discernment, you can see signs of Jesus' return all around us. There are the obvious ones such as wars, rumors of wars, nations rising up against nation, famines, earthquakes in various places. However, there are other signs not quite so obvious. We are in a change of season. There has begun an awakening on the hearts of men.

Luke 1:17 This verse is talking about John the Baptist. "He will also go before Him (Jesus) in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord"

Doesn't this sound like the verse on the front of the bulletin that is found in Malachi? This verse is in the Old Testament and the New Testament. This verse is starting to happen! But we don't see it because of all the other distractions the enemy has thrown our way. Now, back to the road signs. Have you ever been driving along and you are pre-occupied with life thinking about your day, or the kids, or the next appointment you have to make, and you miss a sign? Perhaps it was the exit off the highway that you needed or a slower speed limit sign and you have an officer right behind you, or a detour ahead sign you missed. Any of these instances are times we wish we had been paying closer attention to the signs!

This is also how it is with spiritual signs. We need to pay attention! We can't be too busy with life or allow our selves to get distracted and not see the signs that the Lord is doing in the world today. They are pointing us to His soon return. These are signs I am very excited to be noticing! Keep your eyes up and focused on the things of God and you will see those signs too.
