All things are possible to him who believes

Mark 9:23 (NASB)
“And Jesus said to him, If You can? All things are possible to him who believes.”

Welcome Guests!
 Thank you for visiting us today! We hope you help yourself to a refreshment in the Hospitality Area before or after the service.

In the verse that is quoted on the front of our bulletin, Jesus states that, "All things are possible to him who believes." In the next verse a dad cries out, "I do believe; help my unbelief." This dad is not alone in the area of needing help to figure out exactly how we get unbelief out of our lives. So, what does it mean to believe? From the Merriam Webster Dictionary, Believe is defined as to have faith or confidence in the existence of (something).



And Dictionary.com states, "to have confidence in the truth, the existence or reliability of something." If we put all of those pieces together in a Bible context, we run right into these scriptures: Hebrews 11:6, "And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must **believe** that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him." He is... Love. 1 John 4:8, "God is love."

He is Provider - Genesis 22:8, "And Abraham said, My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering." and Philippians 4:19, "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

He is Healer- Exodus 15:26, "... For I AM the Lord who heals you."

He is our Peace - Philippians 4:7, "and the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

These are just a few of His attributes. So these are the truths we can have confidence in.

Mark 11:22 states, "Have faith in God". This does not say, "have faith in the preacher" or "have faith in my ability to accomplish this," or "have faith in the government benefits," it doesn't even say "have faith in the prayer team" (even though it is great to have prayer warriors in agreement with you), but have faith in this loving Heavenly Father.

And then we can take a look at the reliability of God. Malachi 3:6, "For I am the Lord, I do not change." Psalms 15:4, "...He who swears to his own hurt and does not change."

James 1:17, "Every good and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning." Hebrews 13:8, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever." Wow! Our God is reliable!!

And the last facet of believing that we will look at today is faith, (believing) comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. The more time we spend reading, hearing, and meditating on God's Word, the faster the doubt and unbelief will dissipate from our lives. Enjoy the service today. Take plenty of notes and re-read the verses you noted or that Holy Spirit brought to your attention. Meditate on these scriptures and watch your believing increase. Then get excited, because remember, "All things are possible to him that believes."
