Can Grace Be Nullified or Multiplied?

Our Wednesday night services have been outstanding recently as we have dissected the subject of “Growing Spiritually”. We have had some great discussions about this subject that would benefit anyone and everyone.

Humanity was created in God's image and likeness, meaning we are spirit beings who live in a physical body, express ourselves through our souls (mind, will and emotions), and contact the spiritual realm through our spirit (heart of hearts).

Spiritual growth is an innate aspect of Christianity. God created Adam and Eve in maturity from a **physical** standpoint, but He used words, the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil, and their relationship with Him and His creation to develop their **spiritual** maturity.

From the day Adam and Eve disobeyed God and opened the door for sin to enter the world, mankind has had to choose whether or not to obey the Lord. If we choose to obey, we will step into a measure of grace whereby we will begin to understand what God says and does. If we actually DO what we hear Him say on a consistent basis, we will begin to grow!!!

When Jesus finished the work God had sent Him to accomplish, EVERYTHING CHANGED WITH RESPECT TO GRACE. Instead of measures of grace being given to mankind for specific tasks God wanted done in the earth, Jesus BECAME THE FULLNESS OF GRACE THROUGH FAITH IN HIM! In other words, when we believe the Word of God and apply it in our lives, Jesus guarantees that each and every aspect of your pursuit becomes possible!

The one and only statement God makes about any failure occurring is if we NULLIFY His grace. How can we do that? Through those nasty thoughts of fear, intimidation, unbelief, and unworthiness to accept God's promise as being for you!

The Apostle Peter, a man who knew something about nullifying grace, writes one of the most stunning statements in the Bible. He didn't let his past failures impact his future. He discovered a way out of the grip of impossibility through faith in Jesus! Here's his statement.

2 Peter 1:1-2 (NASB)

¹ **Simon Peter, a bond-servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who have received a faith of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior, Jesus Christ:**

² **Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord;**

Talk about a trump card to lay on the table when it looks like the devil is about to win! Not only is Jesus the fullness of grace, but He is also ready, willing and able to **multiply** OUR grace as we believe, just as Peter believed and confessed 3 times that he loved the Lord. Always remember, faith can only operate by love. As we believe in Jesus, continually pursue increasing knowledge about Him, then love and serve Him with joy, God's grace in our lives will multiply until we are fully mature in Him!
