Persevering in Prayer

Lets face it, sometimes it seems as if it is taking a lot longer to get the answer to a specific prayer than we want it to.

What are some keys to persevering in prayer? Well, I remembered a wonderful book I have which lists seven steps to answered prayer. The name of the book is, "Prevailing Prayer to Peace", by Kenneth E. Hagin. I will list these steps here today, and then I will expound and teach on them Wednesday night. I believe you will find these steps very helpful!

#1 Decide what you want from God. James 1:6, "But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering."

#2 Read scriptures that promise the answer you need. Joshua 1:8, "This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth; but you shall meditate on it day and night...for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you shall have good success."

#3 Ask God for the things you want. Matthew 7:7, "Ask and it shall be given you; seek and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened to you."

#4 Believe that you receive. Mark 11:24, "Therefore I say to you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them."

#5 Refuse to doubt. James 4:7, "...Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." Doubt is of the devil. Resist it!

#6 Meditate on the promises. Proverbs 4:20 - 22, "My son, attend to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life to those that find them, and health to all their flesh. (This is different from step #2, as this keeps your faith active in the middle of your wait.)

#7 Give God the praise. Philippians 4:6, "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be known to God."
