The Kingdom of God

Every kingdom divided against itself can not stand. Over the past couple of months, we have been learning about the two very distinctly different kingdoms. One is very much controlled by Satan, darkness, deception and hatred. The other is controlled by a Loving Heavenly Father, full of light, truth and peace.

One has the MO to kill, steal, and destroy. The other gives us life, and that more abundantly. It is our choice which kingdom we will live in, however, we can't live successfully in both!

From the "Voice of the Martyrs" devotional September 20th

Nikolai Khamara had gone into prison a thief and came out a Christian. After his release, he joined the underground church in Russia. Sometime later, the pastor of Khamara's church was arrested. The authorities tortured him, hoping he would betray the church, but he told them nothing. Then they arrested Nikolai Khamara. They brought him before the pastor and told him, "If you do not tell the secrets, we will torture Khamara in front of you."

The Pastor could not endure someone suffering for him. But Khamara said to him, "Be faithful to Christ and do not betray him. I am happy to suffer for the name of Christ." Then they gouged out Khamara's eyes.

The pastor could not bear it. He cried to Khamara, "How can I look at this? You will remain blind!" Khamara replied, "When my eyes are taken away from me, I will see more beauty than I see with these eyes. I will see the Savior. You must remain faithful to Christ to the end."

When the interrogators told the pastor that they would cut out Khamara's tongue, Khamara said, "Praise the Lord Jesus Christ. There, I have said the highest words that can be said. And if you wish, you can now cut out my tongue." The former thief stole from the officers a chance to rob his faith. He died a martyr's death.

Khamara's story is a lesson in contrasts between the kingdom of God and the kingdom of the devil. The Bible teaches us how to recognize those who steal, kill, and destroy as members in the kingdom of the devil. In Khamara's case, The enemy stole his eyesight, destroyed his speech, and eventually killed him. In contrast, Jesus' kingdom is about life- life to the extreme. As such, Jesus gave Khamara a new life and restored a former thief to righteousness. The two kingdoms are in conflict, and our lives are the spoils. Khamara "defected" to the other side when two believers showed him how to join God's kingdom. What are you doing to bring others into God's kingdom?
