2 Corinthians 4:18 (NASB)

“While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.”

Seven thoughts about decision making.

If you have a major life decision to make it is wise to allow God to lead us in that decision. A life change such as changing jobs, moving, getting married, etc. can create stress in your life and, of course, you want to make the correct decision. Here are seven thoughts to help you navigate the decision-making process.

1. Be Flexible

There are times in your life when you will simply have to be flexible. Often the Lord leads us in directions that we haven't planned for. In fact, we could be happily doing what we think God has led us to do, but then an opportunity arises, or a change unexpectedly drops on us, so we must be flexible and open for new things that God wants to do in our life. Flexibility doesn't mean to compromise. Like a palm tree in a storm, we must be flexible to bend to the winds of change but steadfast enough to have roots that are unmovable.

2. Don't Trust Your Emotions

Actually, we should never trust our emotions. Our emotions are given to us to be human and to enjoy but never, never, never trust emotions to lead you. Do not make life decisions when emotional! Learn to follow peace. Not emotional peace, but the peace of God.

3. Don't Allow Preconceived Ideas to Block God's Moving in Your Life

Many of the Jew's preconceived thoughts about the Messiah blocked their ability to accept Jesus. They were expecting a military man to free them from Roman bondage. We all develop religious beliefs that may be blocking our ability to hear what God is saying to us today. My constant prayer is; "God, show me where my beliefs are wrong."

4. Spend Time in the Word

Refresh yourself in the basics. His Words are spirit and life and give you greater ability to hear what He is saying to you..

5. Worship

Draw near to God so you can better hear from Him. He seeks relationship.

6. Be Led by the Spirit

Holy Spirit lives in us to be our counselor and comforter. He leads us even when we aren't listening, so practice listening to His voice. He will show you things you never knew.

7. Use a multitude of counsel

Talk to people you trust to give you wise counsel. Don't trust any one person because we all make mistakes. Listen most carefully to counsel that aligns with the previous six elements.

God wants to lead us in both major decisions and day-to-day decisions. Use these seven thoughts to help you make wise decisions.
