**What are you saying?**

Ephesians 4:29

"Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers."

Thank you for visiting us today! We hope you help yourself to a refreshment in the Hospitality Area before or after the service.

When I was a little girl I would sing this little song, and I bet you sang it too, “Be careful little eyes what you see”. The words to that child’s song actually have some very profound wisdom in them. “Be careful little eyes what you see, for the Father up above is looking down in love, so be careful little eyes what you see.” The next verse says, “Be careful little mouth what you say, for the Father up above is looking down in love, so be careful little mouth what you say.”

Wow, if we all heeded that advice, I wonder if we would say half of the things that we do say?

In the verse on the front of this bulletin, it states to only say that which is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. Are your words imparting grace? Ouch, hallelujah! Here is an acrostic that I have used before that will help you to keep those words full of grace.

**T**True-- Is what you are about to say true? Not just is it a correct fact, but is it truth? John 8:32, “And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” God’s Word is truth!

**H**elpful-- Will your words be helpful? 1 Corinthians 10:23, “All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful; all things are lawful for me, but not all things edify.” If your words won’t be helpful in a specific situation, don’t say them.

**I**nspire-- Will my words inspire the other person? Inspire means: breathe life into or encourage. Genesis 2:7, “And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living being.” Will those words tear the other person down, or kill their self-esteem. If they will, don’t say them.

**N**ecessary-- Are my words necessary? 1 Corinthians 3:6, “I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.” You may be the one who needs to say something to the person you are visiting with, however, maybe you are just to pray for that person. Perhaps they are not quite ready to receive what they need to hear and your words would do more harm than good. Or, you may just water what someone else has said to this person. It is God’s job to bring about the increase in their life.

**K**ind-- Are my words kind? Ephesians 4:32, “And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.” Be kind when you speak to others. Treat others the way our Father God has treated us, graciously!
