Fear Not
I am with You

Isaiah 41:10
" Fear not for I am with you."

Fear Not!

I frequently notice that the news media over-hypes current events. It seems that they are trying to stir up fear. Perhaps, doing this increases their revenue but I can also think of more sinister reasons that they be doing this. The current hot item in the news is the Corona virus. By my estimation this new virus is about as deadly as the flue that we deal with every winter. Yes, both diseases are credited with killing vulnerable people but the new hot button for the media is the Corona virus. The effect of the news media harping on an issue like this is it tends to instill fear in some people. The more that people become fearful in giving the media more “news” to bring, like empty store shelves. I don’t understand why people wait until there is a “panic” before they rush to the store to purchase soap and sanitizer. Aren’t these the kind of items that we should always have on hand?

Whenever I see people reacting in fear I think about the author of fear. Fear is not of God – our God is a faith God. The enemy wants us to be in fear, therefore we should always resist fear and search to see the source of the fear. Knowing that fear is not of God, we should always resist it.

God has provided means of protection for us no matter what comes against us. The 23rd Psalm and the 91st Psalm provide us great protection, if the truth of these Psalms lives within us. Therefore, I recommend that both of these Psalms be memorized and used to attack fear (or any other evil attack) whenever it tries to come on you.

Psalm 91 (NASB)

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High Will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the LORD, “My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!” For it is He who delivers you from the snare of the trapper And from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with His pinions, And under His wings you may seek refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark. You will not be afraid of the terror by night, Or of the arrow that flies by day; Of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, Or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. A thousand may fall at your side And ten thousand at your right hand, *But* it shall not approach you. You will only look on with your eyes And see the recompense of the wicked. For you have made the LORD, my refuge, *Even* the Most High, your dwelling place. No evil will befall you, Nor will any plague come near your tent. For He will give His angels charge concerning you, To guard you in all your ways. They will bear you up in their hands, That you do not strike your foot against a stone. You will tread upon the lion and cobra, The young lion and the serpent you will trample down. “Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him *securely* on high, because he has known My name. “He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him. “With a long life I will satisfy him And let him see My salvation.” (John Tohline)
