2 Kings 6:17a  
 "And Elisha prayed, and said, "Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see."

Thank you for visiting us today! We hope you help yourself to a refreshment in the Hospitality Area before or after the service.

We walk by faith and not by sight.

Years ago I worked at a childcare center in the church we attended. I was the infant teacher, watching babies from two weeks through two years old. One particular set of parents were in the middle of a very heated custody battle. The dad was not to pick up their children until this case was settled in court. One morning he did show up and was attempting to take his infant child from my room. As I stood between him and the baby who was sitting on the floor, he became very aggressive for a couple of minutes and then his demeanor suddenly changed. Then he said the strangest thing, he said, "ok I won't hurt her.", and left my classroom. Security had been called, as well as the police. My director had witnessed the last moment in my room including this dad's statement. She asked what made him back down and leave my room. He was very shaken and told her he saw the "big guys" behind me and decided to leave. GLORY TO GOD!!

I told you the story of this incident as it reminded me an account in the Bible. In 2 Kings, chapter 6, you can read all about it. Elisha's city was surrounded by a great army with horses and chariots. Elisha's servant was very scared and said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" Elisha's answer was, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." And Elisha prayed, and said, "Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around to protect Elisha.

Even when we can't see with our physical eyes what God is doing, we need to have clear spiritual vision of what is happening in the spiritual realm. Praying in the spirit is the best way to get a clear picture of what is going on in the heavenly realm.

I will always believe the aggressive dad saw angels standing behind me to protect me and the baby he came to take. God was on the scene working on my behalf.

We, as a nation in much turmoil, must look at the circumstances around us with the eyes of the spirit, knowing that God is at work. Election results are not final until God says they are. God is the general of the heavenly hosts and I believe angels are busy exposing darkness and tipping the scales towards justice and righteousness. Truth will prevail. The unrest we may be feeling is the devil pushing hard before God releases a mighty revival that will bring in the greatest harvest we have yet to see.

My prayer for you is the same as Elisha's was for his servant. Open their eyes Lord so that they may see!!
