He is willing!

Matthew 8:2-3
 "And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing..."

GOOD NEWS ALERT: Jesus paid the price for you to walk in health!! (Pastor Joslyn)

Isaiah the prophet prophesied that Jesus would bare our sickness and disease in His own body and become our substitute, so that we do not have to suffer from sickness and disease:

"It was our sicknesses that He Himself bore, And our pains that He carried; Yet we ourselves assumed that He had been afflicted, struck down by God, and humiliated. But He was pierced for our offenses, He was crushed for our wrongdoings; the punishment for our well-being was laid upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed. All of us, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the LORD has caused the wrongdoing of us all to fall on Him."

Isaiah 53:3-6 NASB2020

Jesus bore our sins on the cross so that we could be forgiven and redeemed. Thank God!! Because of His sacrifice, we can spend eternity in Heaven and never see hell. But, in His goodness, Jesus also took stripes on His back, when He was whipped (and His body was broken) so that we might be healed physically!! Above, Isaiah says "by His wounds we ARE healed" prophesying the future. But I Peter 2:24 says "by His stripes we WERE healed" because Jesus has paid the price!! Glory to God!!

Matthew confirmed that Jesus "carried away our sickness".

"Now when evening came, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed; and He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed ALL who were ill. This happened so that what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled: "HE HIMSELF TOOK OUR SICKNESSES AND CARRIED AWAY OUR DISEASES." Matt. 8:16-17 Glory to God, if Jesus carried them away-they are NOT OURS!!

Sadly, there is much sickness in the world today, but I want to encourage you to NOT FEAR, but look to Jesus and His Word!! Here are just a few keys for walking in health:

#1 Know that it is God's will for you to walk in health! As you read all four of the Gospels you can see that Jesus healed every form of sickness and disease, but NEVER EVER made anyone sick. We will never be sick in heaven and the Lord told us to pray that His will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Matthew 6:10

#2 NEVER allow the devil, "the accuser of the brethren" (Rev. 12:10) to condemn you when you are fighting sickness or disease. Sometimes sickness comes, but RESIST IT and do what James 5:14-15 says: "Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord; and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and THE LORD will raise him up." Praise God!! Then give Jesus the glory for your healing!!!

#3 Sickness is an enemy and we must fight it every way we can!! It not only robs us of our health but of our finances, our energy and the ability to work for God to build His kingdom. Once you know and understand that sickness is an enemy, you always want to resist it and fight it AS SOON AS you get the smallest symptom. Speak Gods Word!! (Also, walk in wisdom - eat right, get plenty of sleep, don't share drinks, and wash you hands!!)

#4 As a Believer in Jesus, He has given YOU authority to use His Name and command sickness to LEAVE your body, in the Mighty Name of Jesus. Acts 3:6 "But Peter said, "I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth - rise up and walk!" Verse 8 says "And with a leap, he stood upright and began to walk; and he entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God." Hallelujah!! I love that so much!!!

#5 The Best way to resist and fight sickness and disease is to PREVENT IT before it comes by filling your spirit, mind and heart with the word of God and building your faith!! That way, your battery will be charged and ready to fight ahead of time if an attack comes!! There are so many healing scriptures in the Bible. If you need help knowing where to go and read, please talk to one of the staff members or one of the leaders at VCF and we will gladly help you!! God's Word never fails!!
