Have you ever read a scripture that you have read many times before, but this time one thought jumps out at you. This past week, that very thing happened as I was reading this verse: Matthew 12:15, “But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, AND HE HEALED THEM ALL.”

Great multitudes. That sounds like a lot of people, perhaps comparative to a stadium full of people at a football game or concert. I’ve been in some of those crowds, and I can assure you that they are not all Godly saints walking in perfect love. Many of them are probably not even Christians.

Now for those of us that have occasionally missed the mark, yelled at our kids, told a lie, didn’t walk in love, or were submitting to fear, God’s word has the answer for us. I do want to mention however, our disobedience does not change God’s Word, it changes our position to accept the blessings of God. I am so thankful for 1 John 1:9, I use it daily.

1 John 1:9, “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

And for those who are not Christians yet, I have always heard that healing is the “dinner bell” for the Gospel. Why wouldn’t a loving God want to show His goodness to ALL? For God so loved the WORLD...
