Daniel 1:20

God's Wisdom

There are so many parallels from the book of Daniel to the life we are living in now. The Old Testament is a type and shadow of the New Testament, and written for our example.

The Hebrew young men, that we know as Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, had situations where their Christian belief system was challenged often. They were even challenged as to what they ate! The two big challenges that we are familiar with are daily prayer, and the refusal to bow to idols. These accounts are common place, Sunday School lessons from our childhood that are used over and over. Daniel in the lion's den and Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego in the fiery furnace, read them and have the tee-shirt.

With the last nine months in our rear-view mirror, I can honestly say I have felt like I have been in situations very similar to those in the book of Daniel!. Government mandates that I refuse to obey as they contradict the commands I read in God's Word. Tell your friends and neighbors that you attend church every Sunday and that we don't require masks, that can be a fiery experience right there. Stand out side a Planned Parenthood site and pray. That will most certainly make you feel as if there are hungry lions ready to pounce on you.

As I read through the book of Daniel there was a phrase that jumped out at me, I saw this phrase several times in fact. In Daniel 4:8 we read, "But at last Daniel came before me...in him is the Spirit of the Holy God."

Daniel 5:11, "There is a man in your kingdom in whom is the Spirit of the Holy God. And in the days of your father, light and understanding and wisdom...were found in him"

Daniel 5:14, "I have heard of you, that the Spirit of God is in you, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you."

In these verses we see that Daniel had wisdom for all of the circumstances he found himself in because the Spirit of God was in him! That is great news for you, because if you are born again, the Spirit of God is in YOU!! Look at what the Word says in 1 Corinthians 1:30, "But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God- and righteousness and sanctification and redemption."

James 1:5, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him."

There will always be adverse situations in life. Decisions we must make, and stands we need to take to live a life that brings glory to our Father God. Take time to pray in the Holy Ghost before you make any decisions. You will walk in light, and excellent wisdom will be found in you! Then watch the great victories that will be told about you! You will be walking with a fourth man in the fire and your clothes not even smell of fire, God will close the mouths of the lions for you too.
