Different Kinds of Prayer

How many of you played sports in high school?? Football, baseball, basketball, wrestling, track, golf, gymnastics or cheerleading??? I would venture to say that every time you participated in sports, you had to learn the rules and maybe even the plays that the quarterback or other leader would call during the game. Am I right? What would happen if you tried to play basketball according to the rules of football, or golf according to the rules of baseball? We all know that would not work!! Each different sport has a different group of rules that must be followed by each participant.

Sadly, many Christians know more about sports than they do about prayer. Did you know that in the Bible there are MANY DIFFERENT KINDS OF PRAYER??

And, in a sense, they all have “rules” to follow in order for your prayers to get results!! For example, if you are going to pray the Prayer of Faith, you must understand and **KNOW** what the will of God is from His Word.

Such as: Does God want all to be saved? Did Jesus pay for our Healing? Is the gift of the Holy Spirit for every believer? **YES! YES! YES!**

When you want to pray the Prayer of Agreement with someone, you need to have someone agree with you that has the same Spirit of Faith in God’s Word. Pastor Brian and I always saw the most results when we prayed together in agreement!! All Glory to Jesus!! His Word is true!!

Today I am going to begin teaching on The Different Kinds of Prayer and will continue in the next couple weeks. To live a Victorious Christian life, we all need to understand the Glorious principles of Prayer that God gives us in His Word. PRAYER is fellowship with God, our Heavenly Father. No matter what we are praying about, the key is engaging our hearts with the Lord.

Here are the main Kinds of Prayer in the Bible:

- 1) The Lords Prayer. Matthew 6:9-13
- 2) The Prayer of Thanksgiving. Philippians 4:6
- 3) The Prayer of Consecration. Matthew 26:39
- 4) The Prayer of Commitment. 1 Peter 5:7
- 5) The Prayer of Faith. James 5:15
- 6) The Prayer of Agreement. Matthew 18:19
- 7) Praying in the Holy Spirit in Tongues. Romans 8:26, Jude 1:20
- 8) The Prayer of Intercession. 1 Timothy 2:1-2, John 17
- 9) Persistent Prayer. Luke 18:1
- 10) The Prayer of Praise and Worship. Acts 13:2-3



There are many other scriptures we will look at, but I encourage you this week to begin to study Prayer along with me and we will have a Glorious first month of 2021.

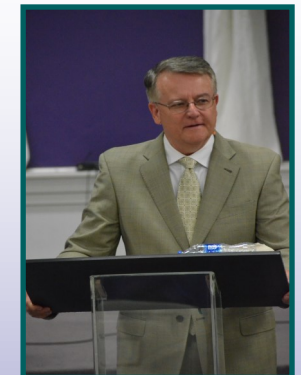
