Interceding for a Nation

In the verse on the front of the bulletin, we sometimes grumble about having to pray for “that” leader. I recently pulled out my copy of The Interceding Christian, by Kenneth E. Hagin, he has some great wisdom concerning this verse. I would like to share this wisdom with you today.

*Paul said in this scripture, “I exhort therefore, that, first...” Let’s put first things first. In life we suffer many times because we don’t put first things first. We let secondary things predominate and neglect things that should be first.

But why should this be first? * Paul said to pray for those who are in authority so that we who are Christians “may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.” God is concerned about us and will move even Though those who are in authority may not be Christians. God will answer our prayers and will do some things because of us, that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life.

In verse three of 1 Timothy 2, Paul writes, “For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior.” Isn’t that what we aim for? Doing that which is acceptable to God. Then in verse four we can see God’s ultimate goal; * “Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.” God’s ultimate purpose in this is that we will be able to spread the gospel. If we do not have good government where there is quietness and peace, it hinders the spread of the gospel. In time of political upheaval we are hindered in spreading the gospel. God wants to get the truth out. Jesus said when He was here on earth, “And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nation; and then shall the end come.” (Matthew 24:14). The devil would do his best to see that this is not accomplished.

*Ministers who have traveled extensively in other countries in gospel work tell me that whole other countries are doing some missionary work, America is really about the only one that is carrying the gospel to the world. Naturally, we see why the devil would oppose our nation so he could stop the flow of truth to the whole world. And we can see why God wants us to pray for those in authority, because He would have “all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.”

*The prayer of intercession is, of course, a prayer for others, and this scripture is talking about praying, or interceding, for others. An intercessor is one who takes the place of another or pleads another’s case. God said this concerning Israel, yet there is a spiritual truth that applies to us today. God said, “I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land... but I found no one.” (Ezekiel 22:30) Don’t let that be said about the Christian church of America!! Let’s put a wall of protection around our land through prayer. Let’s stand in the gap for a lost world headed to hell that needs to be able to hear the truth. Put first things first! Pray for those in authority in our nation, producing peace, so that the gospel of Jesus Christ can go to all the world.
