"Prayer that Brings Results"

We started two weeks ago talking about prayer on Sunday mornings, as prayer is one of the foundations of living a Christian life. 1 John 5:14-15 is an important principle to know concerning how to receive answers to your prayers.

"This is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to HIS WILL, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him."

Therefore, we must learn God's Will by reading, studying, and believing what He says in the written Word of God!! If you feel like you don't know how to do that, read the Gospels, look at the life of Jesus, and you will learn and understand the will of God!! Jesus and our Heavenly Father are One!!! (John 17)

Along with having confidence in prayer, another important key is BOLDNESS! Hebrews 4:16 says, "Let us, therefore, **come boldly** to the *Throne of Grace* that we may obtain **Mercy** and find **Grace** to help in time of need." Glory to God!!! I added the emphasis because every time I read this verse I want to sing and shout and rejoice!! We serve the Creator of the universe Who loves us and sits on the Throne of GRACE, not on a throne of judgment!! He freely gives anyone mercy and grace if they will just come boldly and ask Him!!! How wonderful and awesome is that?!! God is good!! When you understand the love of Jesus and His grace, mercy and willingness to help you, it puts more power inside your desire to pray!!

Knowing the Glorious Goodness of our Heavenly Father also makes it easy for us to pray the prayers of Thanksgiving and Praise and Worship!! Truly, we all have so much to be thankful for, and Jesus is worthy of all of our worship!!

Here is an inspiring quote from my beloved husband, Pastor Brian, who really understood mixing Prayer with Thanksgiving and Praise!

"If you really think about it, since 'faith is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen' (Hebrews 11:1), when we give God praise, we are **acknowledging** the releasing of His answer into our lives.

In fact, Philippians 4:8 talks about the combination of Prayer and Petition, with thanksgiving (or Praise) Producing a Powerful Pavilion of Peace over Prayerful People! (I hope you liked that alliteration.) Praise is the earthly evidence you believe you were heard!!

So let me encourage you today, to maintain your watchfulness in prayer until you can PRAISE!! The plan of God will be greatly enhanced in your life if you will."

Lastly, I just want to add that it is also exciting to keep a prayer journal. You can write down things and people you are praying for. Then when you get the answer, write out a PRAISE to the Lord, add the date and you can always rejoice when you re-read your journal.

As an old children's song says, "Read your Bible, Pray every day, and you Grow, Grow, Grow!!"
