Excellence

2 Timothy 2:15
 "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

Excellence

What is Excellence? The root of the word excellent is excel, which means “to rise to the highest place or to pass in accomplishments or achievement, to be distinguishable by superiority.” Excellence does everything with the highest quality and integrity. It is never subpar or mediocre in any way. Excellence stands above the rest.

God, himself is the standard of excellence for us. He is our ultimate example of complete success. We are created in His image. Since we expect excellence from God, we should be willing to demand that same excellence from ourselves.

In ministry, a spirit of excellence is a desire to reach toward God, rather than get something from God. I really enjoy the New King James version of 2 Corinthians 4:7 as it reads, “But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.” As we spend time studying the Word and abiding in Christ, we start reflecting His excellence. This is how we can develop that spirit of excellence.

A good verse to memorize is, Colossians 3:23-24, “Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” So then, biblically speaking, the pursuit of excellence refers to pursuing and doing the best we can with the gifts and abilities God gives, giving our best to the glory of God. Excellence includes doing common, every day things, but in very extraordinary ways regardless of whether people are watching.

Daniel in the Bible was a man that had a reputation of being excellent. Listen to this, Daniel 5:11, 12, and 14, “There is a man, (Daniel) in your kingdom in whom is the Spirit of the Holy God... In as much as an excellent spirit, knowledge, understanding, interpreting dreams, solving riddles, and explaining enigmas were found in this Daniel,...I have heard of you, that the Spirit of God is in you, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you.” Our goal should be that we obtain such a spirit of excellence that everyone we come in contact with can see it in us.

Proverbs 22:29 says, “Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; he will not stand before unknown men.” What a great promise!

Many things may get in the way of human excellence, including apathy, carelessness, or just plain laziness. We cut corners, we shirk, we settle for second best, or third and fourth best, if the effort to achieve excellence is more than what we are willing to give. Don't let this be your standard, after all, you have some kings to stand before.
