When Jesus made His entrance into Jerusalem for Palm Sunday, one of the phrases the crowd shouted was "Hosanna to the Son of David! Hosanna in the highest!"

What does hosanna mean? Hosanna comes from a Hebrew word that means "save now" or "please save", a literal cry for help. From the beginning of time, Jesus' plan has always been to save us from our sins, and while the crowds lining the roads of Jerusalem didn't grasp the whole plan, for a moment, they were able to rejoice that a savior figure had appeared.

The word *Hosanna* seems to be a "special kind of respect" given to the one who saves, saved, will save or is saving now. If so, Hosanna means, 'a special honor to the one who saves', it is quite appropriate to sing during the Palm Sunday through Easter week!

In 1987, Michael W. Smith wrote the song, "Hosanna (Blessed is He who comes). It was sung by church choirs at Easter celebrations for many years to come. I signed it more than one time myself, in sign language. It is a very up beat and fun song. More than that, the lyrics hold such a beautiful declaration. Here they are for you to meditate on:

Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord
Hosanna, Hosanna Ho, Hosanna

King of Israel
Welcome to our Hearts
Here to reign in righteousness
Oh, ruler of the World
Ruler of our Hearts
Now ascend your throne

You are the King of Kings, Hosanna

To Jerusalem, To the sons of Men
riding in on gentle strength
Oh, Come to save your own
Come to give you life,
Hosanna!

He is the King of Kings. Have you welcomed Him in to your heart to reign? He has come to give you life, and that more abundantly, and save you. Let Him in today, and you will be shouting Hosanna as well!!
