Be ye Baptized

Matthew 28:19
 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

Welcome Guests!

Thank you for visiting us today! We hope you help yourself to a refreshment in the Hospitality Area before or after the service.

About 35 years ago I was baptized in a mountain lake. It was a glorious experience I will forever hold dear in my memories. Many people from the church we attended came to witness the event. A friend brought his guitar and we sang many hymns and familiar songs. It never crossed my mind that there were others at the lake that may not have been Christian or wanted to be included in our little ceremony. That day was all about me and my love for my Jesus! Nothing else mattered once I had decided that I was ready to publicly announce my decision to follow Jesus, though I had been born again as a child.

One of my favorite accounts in the Bible is the baptism of Jesus! When I picture the verses of Jesus being baptized I can relate to the fresh air, the reflection of the trees on the water at the lake, and even my long haired, scruffy brother-in-law looking a little like John the Baptist.

Here are some of the verses from the Gospel of Matthew telling of that amazing account of Jesus' baptism:

Matthew 3:13-17, "Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. And John tried to prevent Him, saying, "Indeed to be baptized by You, and are you coming to me?" But Jesus answered and said to him, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then he allowed Him. When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and a lighting upon Him. And suddenly a voice came from heaven, say, "This is My beloved son, in whom I am well pleased."

Glory to God! Can you picture Jesus, with His hair dripping from the water, Holy Spirit descending on Jesus so light and carefree (remember the verse says, "like a dove" not as an actual dove) and then hearing the voice of God the Father speak!! That, right there, was all three entities of the deity present at one time! God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, the trinity— three in one!

One more scripture to think on today; Galatians 3:27, "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ, have put on Christ." We put on the Anointed One and His anointing! What an extreme honor! Walk in that anointing all the days of your life.

Now, back to the day I was baptized. That day, so long ago now, is so branded in my memory, it seems like just last summer. No, I didn't hear an audible voice speak, but way down in my spirit I felt as if Father God was speaking those same words, "I am well pleased."

To those of you who have decided to be baptized today, listen for that still, gentle voice of the Father, speaking to your spirit. You too will hear, "I am well pleased."
