Healing the Broken Hearted

Psalms 34:18
 "The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart..."

Broken Hearted

I won't ask for a "show of hands", but how many of you would say, that over the years of your life, you have had a broken heart? That is such a broad subject, isn't it? A broken heart can occur from any number of things. Possibly it was from a marriage that has dissolved, the death of a loved one, a child that has gone astray, a dream that has been deferred, the list could go on and on. The ache is real, however, in the midst of that pain, there is a great promise to hold on to.

When Jesus was on the earth, as He sat in the temple, He was handed the scroll to read. He found the place where it was recorded from Isaiah 61, the prophecy about His ministry. Luke 4:18, and 21, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;" V.21, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

Jesus came to mend the brokenhearted! Psalm 147:3 says, "He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds!"

We see this over and over in the New Testament. I have taught on this a few times over the years, and the greatest example of this is when Jesus talked with the Samaritan woman at the well. As I went to study this account once in preparation to teach, the Holy Spirit opened this verse up in a very precious way. I hold the conversation I had with Him dear to my heart, as He shared her story with me. He preface His words very passionately, yet firmly with me as He stated, "It isn't anyone's business, but I will share the details with you for teaching purposes." "Yes, the woman had five husbands. Twice she was widowed, once she was physically abused, once her husband left her for a younger, prettier woman. The last man she was with, she wasn't married to out of fear of yet another broken heart." He showed me that He had purposely sought her out to bring salvation to her and to introduced her to the Messiah. He had saw her tears from each of the situations she had walked through, and was there to give her refreshing, living water. She felt totally unworthy, she was after all a Samaritan. But that was exactly what He was called to do, as we saw in Luke 4.

No, I don't know how your heart has been broken, and as Holy Spirit said, it is not my business. But this I will tell you, Jesus has living water for you. He has saw every tear that you have shed, He is anointed with burden removing, yoke destroying power to set the captives free. He will open your eyes to see how precious you are to Him and He desires for your to walk in the liberty only He can provide!
