Mothers in the Bible –Our Examples

When I was the children's pastor, one of my favorite things to do was study the Old Testament Characters and teach kids how to apply their stories to our daily lives. Thankfully, God gave us many wonderful examples to follow! Though so much in our world has changed since Bible times, humanity really hasn't changed that much. Mothers loved their children then, just like we do today. Let's focus on one characteristic from each of these women that we can emulate as mothers.

Jochebed—Mother of Moses "I Will Trust God to Protect My Child"

Exodus 2:3, 9 "But when she could hide him no longer, she got a papyrus basket for him and coated it with tar and pitch. Then she placed the child in it and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. "Pharaoh's daughter said to her (Jochebed), "Take this baby and nurse him for me, and I will pay you." So the woman took the baby and nursed him. "

I remember reading this story with fresh eyes when Jeremiah was a baby. I can't imagine the fear and desperation Jochebed faced as she prepared that basket, and left her baby in the Nile, but she knew she had to do something to keep her baby safe. She did her part to protect her child, just like we do, but then had to trust God to take it from there. I can only imagine the elation she felt when the princess gave him back to her! Just like God protected Moses miraculously, we can trust Him to protect our children!

Hannah—Mother of Samuel "I Will Pray for My Children, and Give Them to God"

1 Samuel 1:27 "I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him. "

We all know the story of Hannah, crying out to God in her barrenness and God answering her prayer with a son. You'd think the story would end there, like it did for several other women, but it doesn't. Hannah cared for him until he was weaned, and then took him to live at the house of God! How emotional must that day have been?! She recognized Samuel was God's, not hers. As moms, let's commit to not only pray for our children, but give them to Jesus, and fully trust Him to take care of them.

Bathsheba—Mother of Solomon "I Will Teach My Child to Follow God, Despite My Circumstances"

Proverbs 1:8 "Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. "

Proverbs 31:2-3 "Listen, my son! Listen, son of my womb! Listen, my son, the answer to my prayers!

³Do not spend your strength on women, your vigor on those who ruin kings. "

Can you imagine being in Bathsheba's shoes? She was pulled into the king's bed, her husband was murdered and then she lost her baby. Then, God in His mercy gave her a second child, Solomon! I wish we knew more of her story, but I believe she poured so much love into him! She taught Solomon how to turn to God and lean on God and not his own understanding. God honored her faithfulness, despite her circumstances, and chose her son to become the next king. Teach your children, you never know what God's plan is for them and who they are going to grow up to impact!
