Our Father

Today is the day we have set aside to honor fathers. I had a wonderful daddy! He is the one who put a love for Jesus in my heart, he made me laugh, could whistle any tune you asked him to, and was the best player for hide-n-seek! I have many great memories of my daddy. Unfortunately, not all of us have these type of memories of the father we had as we grew up.

I have been truly grieved, as I have heard many of the kiddos I had in child care or children's church, make statements that they did not want to turn out like their father. For these precious ones, and perhaps you have the same sentiments, I would like to share a few verses from the Bible.

Three years ago, my son and daughter-in-law adopted a set of twins. All of our family has embraced these cuties as our flesh and blood! Romans 8:14—16 says, "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, 'Abba, Father.' The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God." That title "Abba" equates to our more familiar term, Daddy. Wow, God Himself is our daddy!

Here is another great verse we can celebrate over, Galatians 4:6-7. "And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His son into your hearts, crying out, 'Abb, Father!' Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son (child), and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ."

So lets look at a few attributes of our Daddy God. First, God is Love. Not that He has the ability to love us, but He is total love incarnate! God is good. Psalm 107:1, "Oh give thanks to the Lord for HE IS GOOD." (emphasis mine) God is a giver and a rewarder. John 3:16, For God so loved the world He GAVE..." and Hebrews 11:6, "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and He is a REWARDER of those who diligently seek Him." (emphasis mine) One of the characteristics of God that I admire is, God does not change. Malachi 3:6, "For I am the Lord, I do not change." Praise God, He is not always changing. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever!

I could go on for pages of the character and attributes of God. He is, after all, Way Maker, Miracle Worker, the Great I Am, Jehovah (Jireh, Nissi, Rapha, Tsidkenu, Shalom, Sshammah, Ra'ah). And so much more!

There is one last characteristic I want to mention, that I feel some of us need to know. God does not lie! Numbers 23:19, "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?" If you have been hurt by a father that did not keep his word, you now have a Daddy God that will always keep His word, He is our Promise Keeper!

For all of our dad's out there, we honor you! You are our unsung, unpraised, unnoticed heroes, and we need you! You have a great responsibility. If you ever need help in the father department, you have the great pattern to follow after, from the scriptures above. Ephesians 5:1, "Therefore be imitators of God as dear children.
