Genesis 1:27- 28a (NASB)
 "God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. [28] God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; **and rule...**"

Our Authority

(Pastor John)

At creation, God delegated to His man Adam, the authority to rule over the entire world, effectively making him god of this world. Adam didn't have the power to carry this out, so he needed to access his Father's power through his relationship with God. As Adam's descendants, we would have inherited this authority. The serpent (Satan) messed this up when he deceived Adam into giving up his authority. Many years later, Jesus obediently went to the cross and won back our authority. Matthew 28:18 (NASB) And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, **"All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.** The apostle Paul then tells us: Ephesians 2:4 (NASB) But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, [5] even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), [6] **and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.** This passage recounts Christ's conferring this authority on us. In other words, He is returning the authority that Adam lost, back to his descendants. Hallelujah! In the spirit realm, consider yourself seated at the right hand of the Father in Christ Jesus.

What does this mean to us today? Jesus said; Mark 16:17 (NASB) **"These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues; [18] they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."**

Please note that Jesus isn't talking about just pastors or evangelists, He is talking about you! Also notice, the first thing listed as a believer's capability is to "cast out demons." The authority that Jesus has delegated to us is awesome. No, we don't have the power to cast out demons but Jesus backs up the authority that He has bestowed on us with His mighty power.

We all need to learn how to exercise the authority He has given us. Starting today, begin to use your authority as far as your faith allows. With practice your faith will grow and you will begin to see how much authority you have.
