Blessings and Curses

The Bible speaks a lot about blessings and curses. Oh, don't we love hearing about the blessings!! However, if you read in the book of Deuteronomy, a full chapter is dedicated to this. Out of 68 verses, 53 of them are dedicated to curses. Why would that be? So we can know and rejoice in what Jesus redeemed us from!

Galatians 3:13, "Christ *has* redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith." (emphasis mine)

If you have found yourself in an unfavorable setting in your family, your finances, or your health, I am almost positive you will find it in that list that we are redeemed from. Here are a few that I feel are great examples to look at: Deuteronomy 28:22, "the Lord will strike you with consumption, with fever, with inflammation..." REMEMBER, YOU HAVE BEEN REDEEMED FROM THESE BECAUSE OF WHAT JESUS DID FOR US ON THE CROSS!! If your child has a fever, that fever has no right to remain in their body. (Or, in your body if you are fighting sickness.) Same goes for inflammation or arthritis.

Deuteronomy 28:32, "Your sons and your daughters shall be given to another people, and your eyes shall look and fail with longing for them all day long." Wahoo, claim that in blessing form for those prodigal children you are believing to come home!!

Deuteronomy 28:26, "You shall carry much seed out to the field but gather little in..." All of the seed, (offerings that you have given over the years), are to produce a mighty harvest. Claim them as a blessing you have the right to receive.

And then Deuteronomy 28:61 is such an exciting verse because it covers any and everything else that we need turned from a curse into a blessing. "Also every sickness and every plague, which is not written in this Book of the Law, ..." Jesus has you covered!!

I have used many of the blessing verses to pray over my children. They make a great confession! "You are the head and not the tail. You are above only and not beneath! You are blessed when you come in and you are blessed when you go out. You are blessed in the city and you are blessed in the field, All of Abraham's blessings are yours. The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all that you set your hand to do."

And of course, we must add the verses from Numbers 6:24-26, "The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace." Thank you Jesus that we get to walk in these blessings.
