More Than Enough

What would your, “More than enough” look like? For a little women in 1Kings 17:8-16, Her “more than enough” came in the form of oil and flour. In the midst of a famine, she had ran out of food. She was about to use the last measure of flour to bake a small cake for herself and her son, believing it would be their last meal. Enter, Elijah the Prophet! He asked for the cake for himself! As the woman obeyed the Word of the Lord, her jar didn’t run out of oil and her bin didn’t run out of flour for the length of the famine. Some historians believe she fed her whole neighborhood during this time as well. Man, that is a lot of pancakes!!

In 2 Corinthians 9:8, the Bible says, “And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having *all* sufficiency in all things, may have *an abundance* for every good work.” (Emphasis mine)

In the book of Exodus, in chapter 36, Moses wanted to fix up the sanctuary. The people brought in offerings to him, so he could complete the work. They brought in so much, the workers told him, “The people bring much more than enough for doing the work.” and then in verses 6 & 7 the Word says, “So Moses commanded and it was proclaimed in all the camp, Let no man or woman do anything more for the sanctuary offering. So the people were restrained from bringing, for the stuff they had was sufficient to do all the work and more.” Moses had to tell the people to STOP bringing in offerings as he had too much!!

When God is in the middle of our projects, He is more than enough.

Do you remember Jacob and Esau in the Bible? They were brothers and had been estranged for many years. When they were finally going to see one another, Jacob wanted to bring Esau a gift. Jacob presented Esau with a very generous gift. Esau declined the gift and said, “Jacob, I am a rich man. I have enough.” (Genesis 33:9) Do you know what Jacob replied back to Esau? “No brother, take it. I have it ALL.” He didn’t say he was rich, he didn’t say he had enough, he said he had it ALL. What was the difference? Jacob had the blessing of Abraham on him!! Glory to God, now because of Jesus, Abraham’s blessings belong to us!

What if peace is where we need God to step in with His more than enough? Philippians 4:7, “And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” Surpasses all!

God asked this question in Jeremiah 32:27, “Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?” Ask yourself that question and see if you don’t all of a sudden realize the potential of believing the God of too Much! He is more than enough!!
