HE IS RISEN!!!!

As you prepare to read this familiar verse, I encourage you to picture each part of this glorious, greatest day in history!!

“On the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to the tomb. And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door and sat upon it. His countenance was like lightning, and his garment as white as snow: And for fear of him the guards did shake, and became as dead men. And the angel answered and said unto the women; ‘Fear not: for I know that you seek Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here: for HE IS RISEN, just as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord was lying.’ And GO quickly, and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead; and, behold, He goes before you into Galilee; there you shall see Him. They departed quickly from the tomb with FEAR and GREAT JOY and RAN to tell His disciples.” -Matthew 28:1-8 (emphasis added)

Every word of the above scripture is what we base our faith and our life on. Jesus was crucified and shed His blood in order for our sins to be forgiven, and was laid in a tomb. But, GLORY TO GOD,

three days later the Spirit of Holiness raised Him from the dead!! Jesus Christ is alive forevermore and “has sat down at the right hand of the Throne of God” where “He ever lives to make intercession for us”!!! (Hebrews 12:2, 7:25) Hallelujah!!! What a day of Victory we Celebrate!!!

One of my goals today is to help every person appreciate the Sacrifice of Jesus more! Therefore, I want to share about the “TOMB”.

A man who visited Israel visited the tomb where Jesus was laid. There is an elaborate cathedral now that marks the traditional spot of Jesus’ tomb, but a Jewish man took this particular tourist behind the elaborate cupola, through an indiscreet entrance into a rock-hewn tomb. It was dark, musty, and unkempt. This 4ft by 4 ft tomb could be the very one that held the body of Christ, and the place that witnessed history’s greatest moment.

“God put Himself in a dark, tight, claustrophobic room and allowed them to seal it shut. The Light of the World was mummied in cloth and shut in ebony. The Hope of humanity was shut in a tomb.” *

Nothing is blacker than a grave, as lifeless as a pit, or as permanent as death. There may be times in your own life when you feel like you are entombed in a dark world of fear, or that your bodily pain has put you in a world without escape, or a stone seals your exit to peace
