## Sowing and Reaping

Here we are at the latter end of September! This is the month of harvest. Farmers had planted seed in April or May. (In Colorado, our last, average, frost date is May 15th.) The farmer has watched that seed grow throughout the summer and now he is at the point of harvesting that which he planted.

Seed time and harvest. It is a Biblical principle. Genesis 8:22 states, "While the earth remains, seed time and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease."

For the hard working farmer, who has planted a field of corn or wheat seed, that is a great principle to have working for you. A person would think it foolish to plant weed seed, yet expect a crop of corn, or beans, or watermelons! Yet, we do this exact thing in the spirit realm all of the time.

Galatians 6:7-9, "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for WHATEVER a man sows that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, and he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we DO NOT LOSE HEART." (emphasis mine)

Many times we equate these verses with finances, however, there are so many other things we can sow. Here are a few that I thought of: \*Love, \*Time, \*Friendship, \*A smile, \*Kindness, \*Forgiveness, \*Grace, \*Prayer. All of these I would be excited to reap 30, 60 or 100 fold! Can you think of some more?

Then, here are some ways we can sow to the Spirit. You could pray in tongues, pray with your understanding, read your Bible, study your Bible, attend a good Word of Faith church like VCF, or perhaps, meditate on a verse of scripture.

Here are a few seeds I would NOT want to reap a harvest from. Anger, judgement, (judge not least you might be judged), unforgiveness, and though we don't think of this one often, wasted time. Ouch, hallelujah! Keep those type of seeds out of your field!

Also, remember that with the type of measure you use to plant, is the type of measure you will gather with. I like the rest of that scripture as it says, "Give, (good seed that you have planted), and it will be given unto you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over will it be poured unto you!" Praise God! I'm ready for a bumper crop of blessings, are you?
